

- A. Australian Royalties Corporation Pty Limited as trustee of the Australian Royalties Trust (ABN 48 048 343 567) (ARC) presently holds 77,777,778 ordinary shares in Aztec Resources Limited (Aztec Shares).
- B. By an agreement between ARC and Gallagher Holdings Limited (Gallagher) dated 20 November 2006 (Prior Agreement), ARC agreed to sell the Aztec Shares to Gallagher, subject to satisfaction of certain conditions. These conditions have not yet been satisfied.
- C. The parties have agreed to terminate the Prior Agreement on the basis that Gallagher will acquire the 25,925,926 fully paid ordinary shares in the capital of Mount Gibson Iron Limited (Shares) to be issued to ARC on acceptance of the Mt Gibson Iron Limited (MGX) takeover offer for Aztec Resources Limited shares dated 11 August 2006 (Offer) in respect of the Aztec Shares on the terms and conditions set out below.

The parties have agreed as follows:

1. The Prior Agreement is terminated due to non-satisfaction of the conditions to that agreement and each party is released from all obligations under the Prior Agreement.
2. ARC will accept the Offer within 1 business day of the date of this letter agreement.
3. Gallagher will acquire the Shares for a purchase price of 523,333,333 (representing a purchase price of \$0.90 per Share). The Shares must be transferred free from any Encumbrance and with all rights, including dividend rights, attached or accruing to them on the date of this letter agreement.
4. Subject to Clause 8, completion of the transaction (Completion) will take place at 4:00pm (Sydney time) on the day 1 business day after the last of the conditions set out in Clause 6 (Conditions) is satisfied or waived. Completion will take place at the offices of Watson Mangioni at Level 13, 50 Carrington Street, Sydney.
5. At Completion:
 - (a) Gallagher must pay the purchase price in immediately available funds to ARC or as it may direct; and
 - (b) ARC must transfer the Shares to Gallagher and execute and deliver:
 - (i) a share transfer form in respect of the Shares in a form reasonably acceptable to Gallagher; and

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- (ii) any other necessary documents as reasonably required by Gallagher to give effect to the transfer.

6. Completion is conditional on:

- (a) MGX issuing the Shares in accordance with the Offer to ARC;
- (b) there not being in effect any preliminary or final decision, order or decree issued by a governmental or semi-governmental agency or court which restrains, prohibits or impedes Completion occurring for any reason (**Order**);
- (c) no legal action being threatened which, in the reasonable opinion of ARC, is likely to result in this letter agreement being rescinded or ARC incurring any liability to a third party as a result of Completion (**Claim**); and
- (d) the Treasurer (or his delegate) providing written advice, either unconditionally or on conditions which are reasonably acceptable to Gallagher, that there are no objections under Australia's foreign investment policy to the proposed acquisition by Gallagher of the Shares or, following notice of the proposed acquisition of the Shares having been given by Gallagher to the Treasurer under the Foreign Acquisitions and Takeovers Act 1975 (Qwith), the Treasurer ceases to be empowered to make any order under Part II of that Act because of lapse of time.

7. Gallagher must use its reasonable commercial endeavours to satisfy the Condition set out in Clause 6(d) as soon as possible. A Condition may be effectively waived only by agreement between the parties.

8. If:

- (a) an Order or Claim is made and not withdrawn; and/or
- (b) the condition in Clause 6(d) is not met,

by the Sunset Date, then ARC may terminate this letter agreement by notice in writing to the other party in which case, both parties' obligations under this letter agreement will cease with effect on and from the time of issue of that notice.

9. For the purposes of this Clause 8, the **Sunset Date** means 4pm (Sydney time) on Friday 22 December 2006 or such later date as may be determined by ARC.

10. By executing this letter agreement, each party represents and warrants to the other as follows:


- (a) it has full power and authority to enter into and perform its obligations under this letter agreement;
- (b) it has taken all necessary action to authorise its execution, delivery and performance of this letter agreement in accordance with its terms;
- (c) its obligations under this letter agreement are legal, valid and binding, subject to any necessary stamping and registration, and are enforceable against it in accordance with its terms subject to applicable bankruptcy laws and equitable principles;

- (d) the execution, delivery and performance of its obligations under this letter agreement complies with:
- (i) each law, regulation, authorisation, ruling, judgment, order or decree of any governmental agency;
 - (ii) its constitution or other constituent documents; and
 - (iii) any Encumbrance or document which is binding upon it or any asset of it and does not and will not result in:
 - (A) the creation or imposition of any Encumbrance or restriction of any nature on any asset of it under the provisions; or
 - (B) accelerate the payment of any obligation existing under any Encumbrance or document which is binding upon it or any asset of it; and
- (e) it has taken all necessary action to authorise the execution, delivery and performance of this letter agreement in accordance with its terms.
11. ARC acknowledges that it enters into this agreement in its capacity as trustee of the Australian Royalties Trust (Trust) and in no other capacity.
12. ARC represents and warrants to Gallagher that:
- (a) it is the only trustee of the Trust and no action has been taken or is proposed to remove it as trustee of the Trust;
 - (b) it has the power under the terms of the Trust to enter into and comply with its obligations under this letter agreement including the power to sell the Shares;
 - (c) it has a right to be fully indemnified out of the Trust assets in respect of obligations incurred by it under this letter agreement and the assets of the Trust are sufficient to satisfy that right of indemnity and all other obligations in respect of which the trustee has a right to be indemnified out of the Trust assets;
 - (d) there are no Encumbrances over or affecting the Shares;
 - (e) when issued, the Shares will be fully paid; and
 - (f) on Completion, the Buyer will receive valid and marketable title to the Shares.
13. It is the intention of the parties that this letter agreement is legally binding.
14. This letter agreement is subject to the laws of the State of New South Wales and each party submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the State of New South Wales.
15. This letter agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts each of which, when executed, is deemed to be an original and the counterparts will constitute one and the same instrument.
16. Each party must do all things necessary to give full effect to this letter agreement and the transactions contemplated by this letter agreement.

17. This letter agreement supersedes all previous agreements and other documents in respect of its subject matter and embodies the entire agreement between the parties.
18. Subject to Clause 19, if GST is imposed on any supply made under this letter agreement by one party (the **Supplying Party**) to another party (the **Receiving Party**) and GST has not been taken into account when determining the consideration payable or to be provided for the supply, the Receiving Party must pay, in addition to and at the same time as that consideration is payable or to be provided for the supply, an additional amount in cash calculated by multiplying that consideration (without deduction or set-off) by the prevailing GST rate.
19. The Receiving Party is required to pay any amount of GST to the Supplying Party on the date the Supplying Party has made demand for payment by means of a Tax invoice in immediately available funds.
20. For the purposes of this letter agreement:
- (a) capitalised terms have the meanings given to them in this letter agreement;
 - (b) **business day** means a day (other than a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday) on which banks are open for general banking business in Sydney; and
 - (c) **Encumbrance** means any:
 - (i) security for the payment of money or performance of obligations, including a mortgage, charge, lien, pledge, trust, power or title retention;
 - (ii) right, interest or arrangement which has the effect of giving another person a preference, priority or advantage over creditors, including any right of set-off; and
 - (iii) third party right or interest or any right arising as a consequence of the enforcement of a judgment,
 - (iv) or any agreement to create any of them or allow them to exist.


